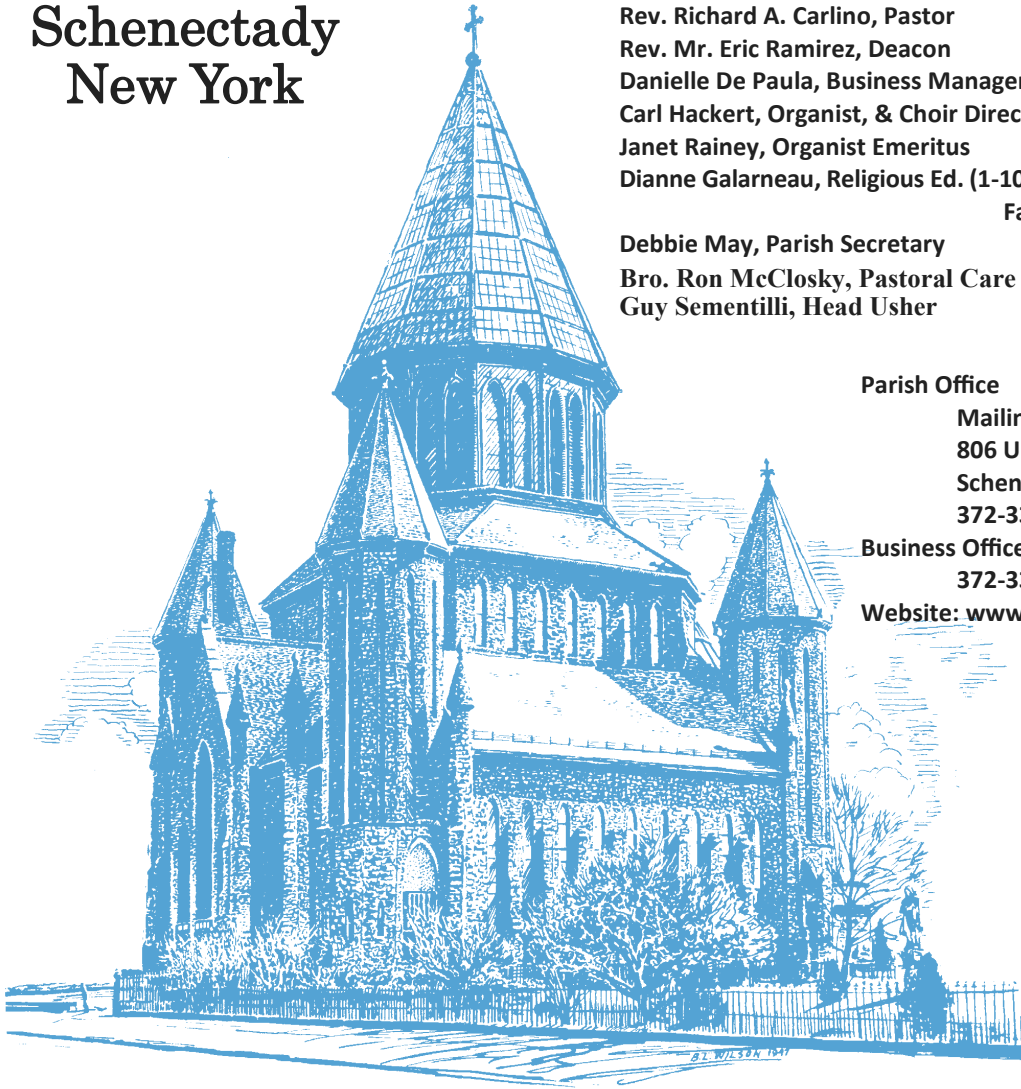

**The Secret of Bernadette and The Pope
of Mercy**

An exploration into the apparitions of Our Lady of Lourdes to Bernadette Soubirous in 1858, as well as into the character and holiness of St. Bernadette, the secret of what made her such a great saint, and the incredible reality of her beautiful, incorrupt body 130 years after her death. The film also reveals the little-known and amazing link between the visions of Lourdes and of St. Catherine Laboure, and the Shrine of the Miraculous Medal in Paris where St. Catherine had her apparitions. Followed by the story of the deep relationship between Pope John Paul II and St. Faustina Kowalska, the Polish nun whose visions in the early 20th century were the origin of the incredible devotion to the Divine Mercy. The Pope and nun never met in person, and yet their stories are so intertwined that they significantly marked the entire pontificate of Karol Wojtyla, who established the feast of Divine Mercy and died on the eve of that feast in 2005. BIBLE COURSE: THE FIRST BOOK OF SAMUEL

Kings, Prophets & the God Who Reigns

Join us as we journey through one of Scripture's most dramatic and theologically rich books! The First Book of Samuel bridges the gap between the period of the Judges and the establishment of the kings, telling the story of Samuel — the last of the Judges — who anoints the first two kings of Israel, Saul and David. The course comes from Catholic Scripture Studies. It was created by Fr. Jeffery Kirby, who also delivers recorded lectures for each of the 18 sessions. The course is free, but the workbook cost is \$50. (The workbook is recommended for all participants.) The central theme of First Samuel is the sovereignty of God in the rise and fall of leaders, revealing that true kingship belongs to the Lord, and that human authority only succeeds when submitted to divine will. Whether you are new to Scripture or a seasoned reader, First Samuel will challenge and inspire you. A common theme in this book is that Israel's God acts justly, prospering those who remain faithful and destroying those who reject His ways. That truth is no less relevant today.

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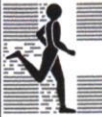
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
